This webinar will include a presentation on Local Exhaust Ventilation, a key control measure for metalworking fluids and welding fume, and an extended Q&A session for anyone that still has questions on controlling exposure to these substances.

Metalworking fluids can cause occupational asthma, occupational hypersensitivity pneumonitis and dermatitis. All welding fumes (including mild steel) are classed as carcinogens.

HSE inspectors are visiting businesses to check that welding work and use of metalworking fluids are planned and carried out correctly to minimise risk to workers' health.
