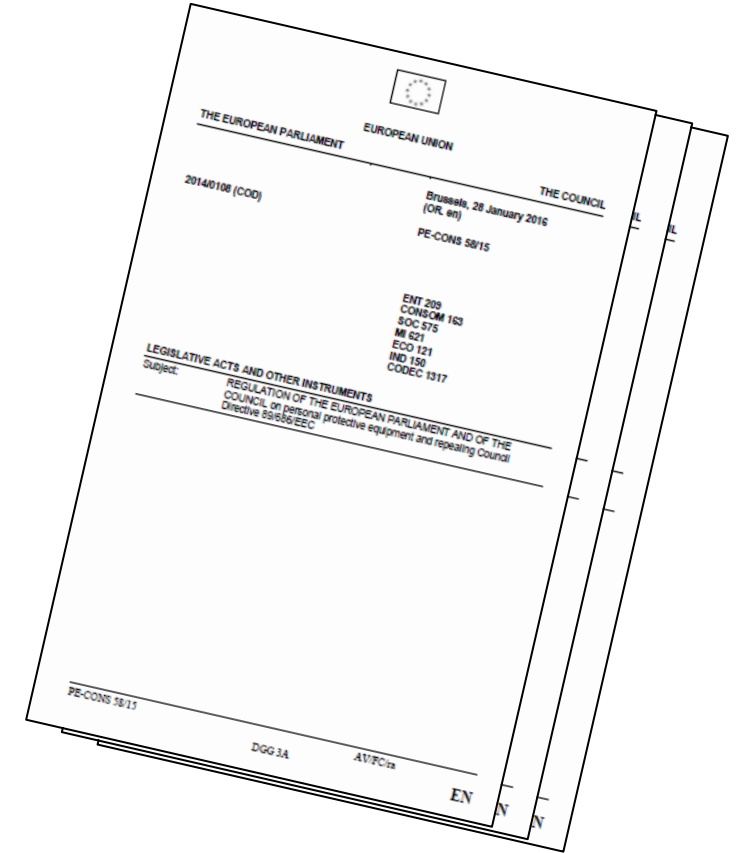

Legislative Effects of UKCA

- The requirements of the PPE Regulation (EU) 2016/425 have been transferred to **Regulation 2016/425 on PPE (as brought into UK law and amended) & Regulation 2016/425 on PPE (Northern Ireland)**
- The Regulation is “*substantially the same*” as the previous EU Regulation
- All terms of compliance and existing obligations and responsibilities are included as is, in the application of the UK regulation
- Harmonised standards at 31st December 2020, have been published as UK Designated Standards – there will be no change to the technical requirements or provisions of the existing standards at this point
- A new mechanism is being created to update UK Designated Standards should EN standards be reviewed and amended after 31st of December 2020
- BSI (National Standards Body) will remain member of CEN - CENELEC
- Market Surveillance Authority remains as is:
 - PPE at work = HSE
 - PPE offered to Private Users = Trading Standard

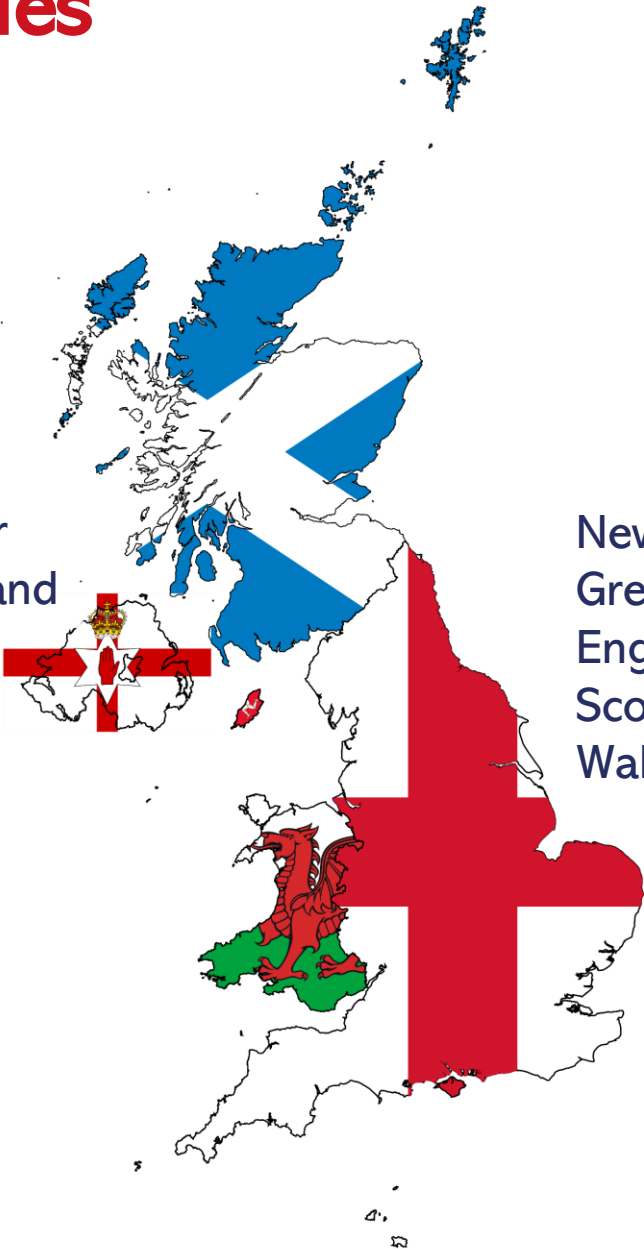

- Conformity Assessment Bodies; Notified Bodies became Approved Bodies on 1st January
- UKCA Mark to be used in GB from 1st January 2021
- CE Marking is permitted for most products until 31st December 2021*
- UKCA Marking must appear on product sold in GB from 1st January 2022
- Manufacturers will be allowed to add or over-sticker with UKCA mark and add to accompanying documents until 31st December 2022
- Northern Ireland is a different situation due to the Northern Ireland Protocol and unfettered access to GB
 - UKNI marked products provided by a NI supplier are only for Northern Ireland
 - CE marked products supplied to a NI supplier can be sold into GB & Northern Ireland

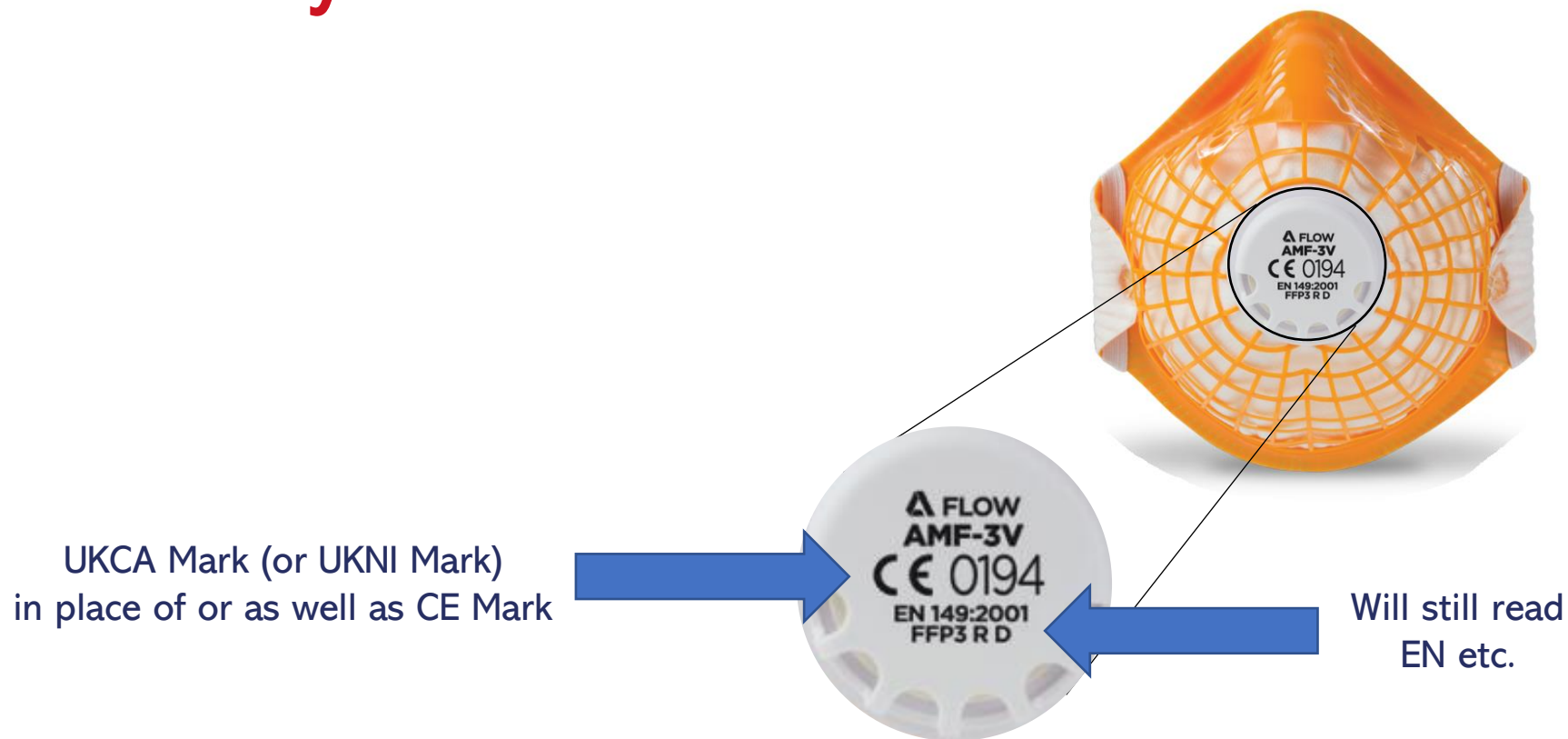

New Product Marking as of January 1st 2021



Marking of products with multiple marks is permitted, providing the Manufacturer can prove that they have had relevant assessment of the product to each of the marks, by relevant assessment authorities

Ensuring Compliance

Check that markings match for the following;

- Declaration of Conformity
- Product
- Packaging
- Any certification provided

If any are missing/different;

- Contact manufacturer or supplier for clarification/proof of compliance
- Contact the Approved Body (UKCA) or Notified Body (CE) to check if certificates are legitimate



Use a BSIF Registered Safety Supplier

- Commit to only provide compliant product
- Annual audit by BSIF on PPE & Quality Management Systems
- Commit to training staff to a recognised qualification in 'Selling Safety'
